On the Eastern side, the dark rocks that stretched far into the ocean glimmered under the bright daylight

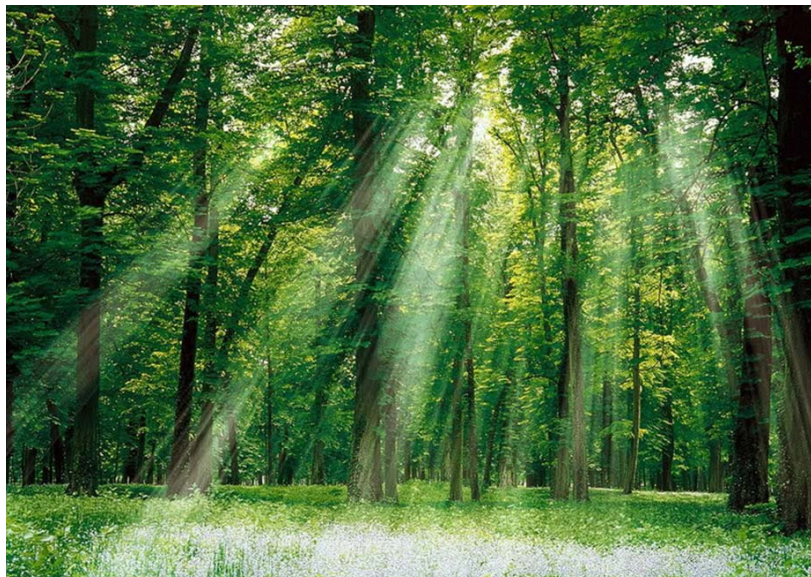


.... out of the longboat onto the sandy patch ...

The glade ( if seen during the day)

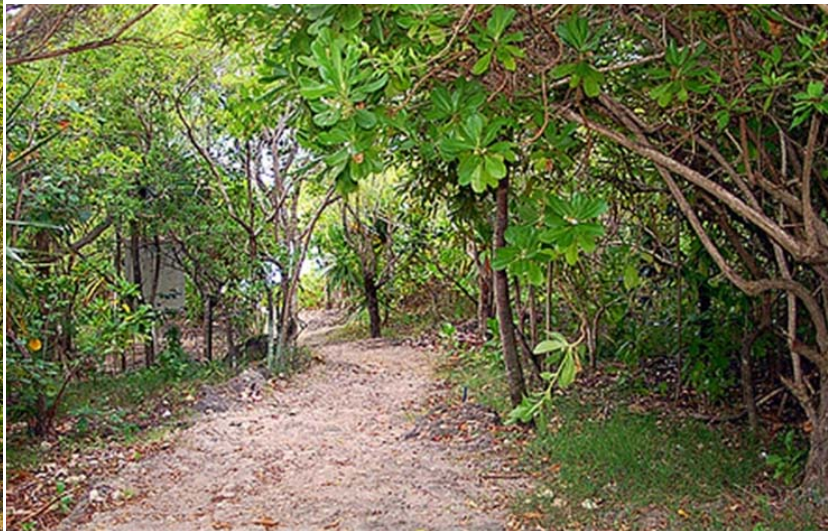


### **Chapter 3: The Fine Print**

### **Chapter 5: Sorcerer**

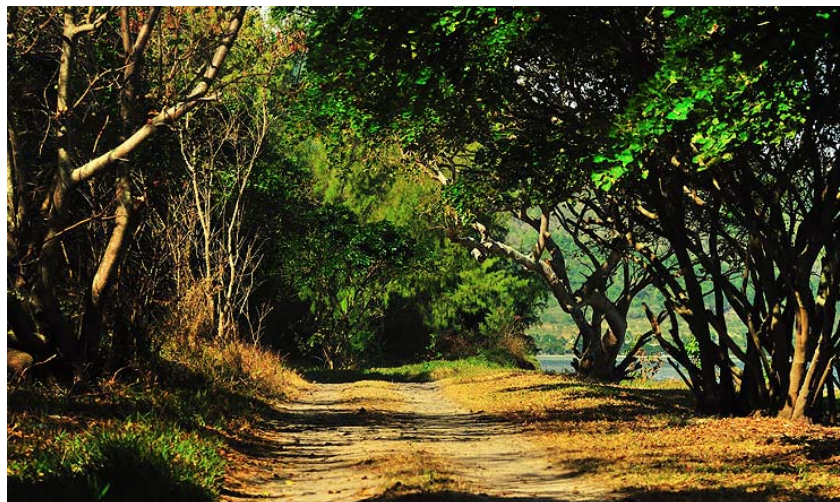


After a short ride, they stopped at a junction with a sandy road.
